Fundraising

The Team Colours Day and the Carnival Sideshow were well received and supported by our school community and gave Year 6 an opportunity to be responsible and shine. We would like to extend our sincere thanks to all parents and carers of our Year 6 students for the help, support, and encouragement you provided your child. We also extend our humble thanks to the many parents and carers who purchased hairspray, tattoos, beads, face paints and many other resources to make the day a success. Thank you.

In total Year 6 have raised \$3250.00. This money is going to be used to fund the social evening: all meals, drinks, graduation cupcakes and decorations, plus purchase a gift for the school and fund part of the bus fare to Jamberoo Recreation Park. As expressed earlier in the year, there will be a Year 6 levy, and this is going to specifically be used to fund the entry to Jamberoo Action Park and the remaining bus fare. As you will understand, when pricing our events, we have found all costs have increased dramatically since last year.

Parent Assistance

In the lead up to the social evening, Stage 3 teachers will require some parental assistance in preparation for the event. We will be seeking assistance in setting up the hall for the evening and in delivering food. We will be purchasing individual meals for students from venues in Woonona and will be looking for volunteers to collect the food and deliver it to us at the school on the night.
