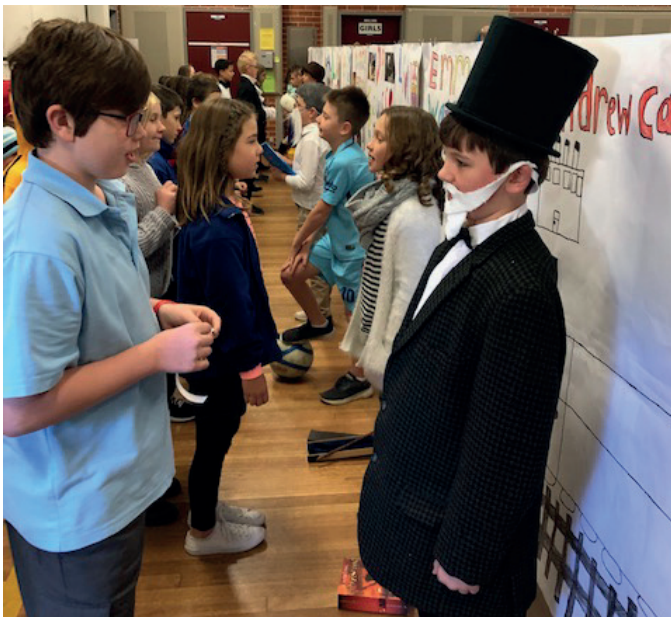


Stage 2 Wax Museum

As has been the recent trend it is open for K-2 and preschoolers to parade and Stages 2 and 3 to dress up if they would like.

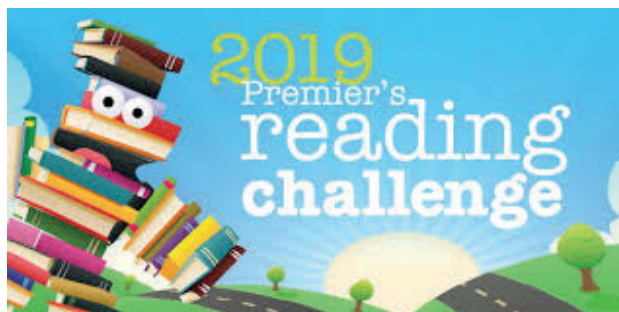


Premier's Reading Challenge

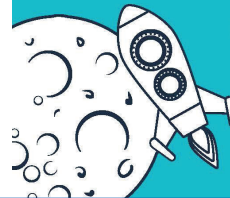
