#### Healthy School Canteen

A very big congratulations to our canteen volunteers for achieving Healthy School Canteen status earlier this term!

The P&C would like to acknowledge the enormous amount of work that went in to this achievement – countless hours of analysing recipes and products, and then making multiple changes to ensure that our school menu complies with the NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy.

We are happy to announce that the Canteen has been successfully recycling Plastic, Paper and Cardboard over the course of the year. This has been made possible with the addition of yellow top recycling bins that the school has sourced, including one allocated especially for the Canteen to use. In addition to this we have saved numerous bags of soft plastic going to landfill by simply recycling it to the Redcycle facility at Woolworths. The introduction of Biodegradable plastic for the fruit cups has been a move in the right direction. We also recycle and repurpose Jars and small Plastic Containers.

Of course these are all small steps however we believe that over the year it has made a considerable difference, and that the community of Woonona Public School should feel proud of the conscious efforts made towards helping the environment.
