We are seeking an individual or preferably a team of co-ordinators/assistant co-ordinators to oversee the running of the canteen.

- Do you want to get to know other Woonona Parents?

Responsibilities involve food ordering, rostering, menu design (optional), overseeing the general running of the canteen and troubleshooting. These roles do not require being present in the canteen every day. More detailed information about these tasks is available on request.

MEDIUM TERM - Review of canteen model underway

Paid co-ordinator, volunteer co-ordinator or outsource the canteen???

Toward the end of 2019, the P&C started to evaluate the different ways school canteens can be run, as it had become increasingly clear that some things must change. Amongst a range of challenges has been filling the roster which at times has placed unfair burden on the coordinators and volunteers, and created uncertainty for families and staff. As a P&C we want to look after our volunteers and school community!

A lot of good but small potential ideas have been investigated (eg students helping in the canteen, swapping recess and lunch breaks, reducing the number of days open), however while these may help, a fundamentally larger change is required.

Consequently a review into the viability, advantages and disadvantages of a range of options is currently underway and will be discussed at upcoming P&C meetings and shared in P&C newsletters. These include:

Continuing the **current model**, with improvements where possible Employing a **paid canteen co-ordinator**

Outsourcing the canteen to an external provider

In all decisions, we will endeavour to put first the best interest of our students, families, staff and all in our school community.
