Location - The new play equipment will be adjacent to the existing playground on the eastern side.

Construction – The playground project will be completed by both Moduplay and volunteers at School Community Working Bee/s:

- Moduplay site preparation and equipment construction
- School Community Working Bees (timber border edging, drainage, mulch and landscaping)

Timing – Installation will occur this year, however the exact timing is dependent on the Department of Education Assets Management Unit (AMU). We will continue to do all we can to get it installed as soon as possible.
